

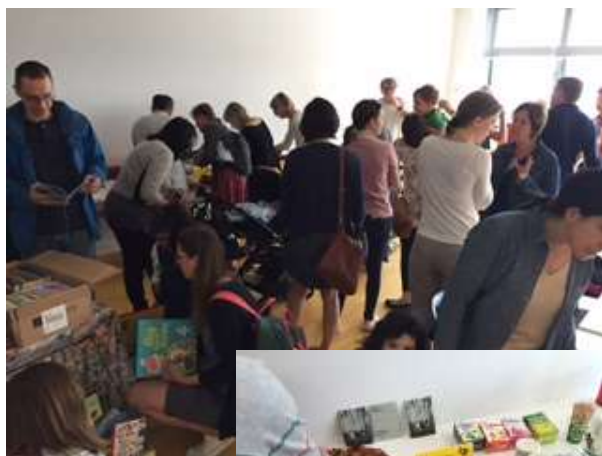
## Road to Rio
