

Signing up to the UCPS easyfundraising account



If you haven't already done so, please consider signing up to easyfundraising to raise free donations for the University of Cambridge Primary School when you are shopping online, especially for any last-minute Christmas shopping!

Since promoting this charityshopping fundraising site in last month's FOCUS newsletter, we have raised an **additional £40** for the school and increased the **total number of UCPS users to 81**. With your help, we can increase these figures next month too!

During the month of December, <u>easyfundraising</u> is giving away £250 in prizes and donations. In addition, the site will donate £5 to the school for every new supporter who joins and raises their first £5.
