







Spelling

Plurals: adding -s and -es

Time to check we can remember the spelling rules.

1 fox  → 3 foxes 
1 robot  → 2 robots 

Remember that, when changing a word from singular to plural, if the word has a hissing or shushing sound at the end then you usually add -es.
