Use what you know about bonds to 10 to work out others, e.g. If I know $4 + 5 = 9$, I also know $14 + 5 = 19$

Add and subtract 2-digit numbers.

How would you work out $35 + 37$? $30 + 30 = 60$ and $5 + 7 = 12$, so $60 + 12 = 72$. Column method can help me.
