### *Solving multiplication word problems*

*Solve the word problem by using the column method that we have learnt. Show how you worked it out.*

*Buns are sold in the bakery for 15p each. I buy six buns. How much do they cost altogether?*

*A car uses 62 litres of petrol per mile. If it goes on a journey of 6 miles, how much petrol will it use?*

*I run a race which is 23 kilometres with four of my friends. How many kilometres did we all run in total?*

*I have 7 friends coming to a bowling party. It costs £16 for each friend to go bowling and then £12 for them each to have a meal. How much does it cost altogether?*

*Challenge: Can you write your own multiplication problems? Try to write two different ones about real life events.*
