**Create a new front cover for the book.**

Think about:

- How will you intrigue your audience and make people want to read it?
- What is one of the most important events in the book?
- Should a particular character feature on the front cover?

**Write the start of the sequel.**

Imagine that another book including the same characters (and maybe some new ones) is coming out. How would it start? How will you make the reader want to keep reading it?

**Create your own version of the story.**

You could make it into a comic strip including the most important events, or turn it into a radio show and record it! You could even turn your book into a play script (if it is a fictional story) or a museum exhibit (if it is non-fiction).

Have fun turning your book into a different genre of writing!

# Book Review Project

**Change the ending**

If your book is a story, can you give it a different ending? You could make the ending mysterious, happy or leave it on a cliffhanger...

**Act out part of the book**

You could dress up as one of the characters and act out with members of your household, or instead create puppets to act out the story.

**Write to the author**

You might like to share your best bits of the story. You could also ask the author some questions about the book or about how they get their ideas for writing.
