Your challenge is to create an ocean/under the sea themed diorama.

Definition of diorama from Cambridge dictionary: a diorama is a model that shows a situation, such as a historical event or animals in their natural environment, in a way that looks real. It can feature models of buildings, plants, animals, or people set against a background. A diorama can use photos and paper, or it can include 3D materials such as Styrofoam, plastic figurines, or natural items such as twigs, shells, or pebbles.
