3. friend Rob had 1 kg and 400 g less, how much rice did Rob have?


4. Abdi originally had 8 kg 200 g of apples, he bought 3 kg and 150 g more, how much² did he have in total?

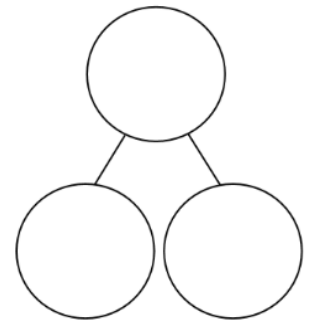
