3. Edit and improve your writing

Questions to ask yourself:



Have I read it out loud to check my sentences make sense?

Have I checked punctuation and spellings?

Have I summarised key facts and answered the 5W Who? What? Where? When? Why?



Have I used a variety of simple and compound sentences?

Have I used conjunctions?

Have I included adverbs and adjectives to add description?



Have I used subordinate clauses?

Have I included fronted adverbials or sentence openers?

Have I thought carefully about my word choices so that they engage the reader?

4. Think creatively of ways to present the information.

These could include:

- Poster
- Video
- Powerpoint
- Theatre performance
