MPI Presenting my own research project

Create a poster advertising for a ticket on board this luxury ship. How will you try to persuade someone to buy a ticket? You might need to find out more about:

- I. price of tickets
- II. Menus for different classes
- III. What you could do on the Titanic

Look at the **who was to blame sheets** and decide who you think was most to blame for the sinking of the Titanic. Present your findings however you like (you could do a powerpoint, record a court case, write an article or any other presentation you like).

Research the newspaper headlines in the **sources sheets** about the sinking of the Titanic. Some of them told fake news!
Write your own newspaper article about the sinking of the Titanic. Remember to find out as many facts as you can, and even include some quotes from survivors.

Titanic Project

Create your own model of the Titanic or parts of the inside. Can you recreate the events of how it sunk?

Using the **timeline sheet**, study the timeline of the events that led up to the sinking of the Titanic. Can you put them in chronological (time) order?

Using the **sources sheet** and your own research, create a museum exhibition about the Titanic. You could invite your family members to view it. What information do you think is most important for people to know?

How has the sinking of the Titanic had an impact on safety at sea and the design of other ships like it?
