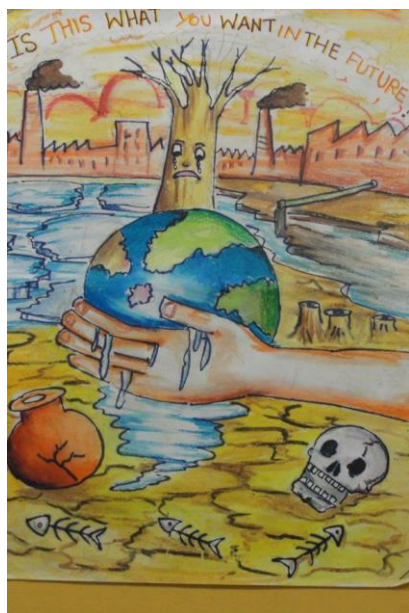


EARTH DAY 2020 THEME: CLIMATE ACTION
